Notification to Parents of Teacher/Paraprofessional Qualifications

In accordance with the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA)/ Parents' Right to Know, this is a notification from Hodgeman County Schools to every parent of a student, in a Title 1 school, that you have to right to request and receive in a timely manner: a) information regarding professional qualifications of your child's classroom teacher and/ or paraprofessionals.

The information regarding the professional qualifications of your child's classroom teacher/paraprofessional shall include the following:

- If the teacher has met the state certification/qualification criteria for the grade level and subject areas taught.
- If the teacher is teaching under emergency or other provisional status through which the state certification/qualification criteria are waived.
- The teacher is assigned in the field or discipline of the certification.
- Whether the student is provided services by a paraprofessional, and if so, their qualifications.

In addition to the above information:

- Parents will be notified if their student has been taught for four or more
 consecutive weeks by a teacher who does not meet the applicable state
 certification requirements at the grade level and subject area in which the
 teacher has been assigned.
- Parents have the right to request their child's state assessment scores, and they have a right to obtain the school and school district state report cards.
